

Some Descendants of James Ferguson of South Carolina

First Generation

1. **James Ferguson, a farmer**, was born about 1785/1788 in Fairfield, SC. He died before 1870 in Pickens, SC. A linkage to other Ferguson of Fairfield County has not been proven. Possibilities are being investigated for a connection to the William Ferguson b 1801 Essex, VA d 1801 Fairfield. This James named his eldest son, William J. M. Ferguson.

BIRTH-CHRONOLOGY: Born about 1785-1788 according to the census of 1840, 1850, 1860. Note that in 1785 The first newspaper, State Gazette of South Carolina was published. That year the county court of Fairfield Dist was established.

CENSUS-PARENTS: 1790 U. S. Census, Fairfield Dist., SC; There are twenty-four heads of household listed on rootsweb.com, index to the Census of Fairfield that could be the parents of James Ferguson, Fargusen, Farguson, Ferguson, or Furgerson.

CENSUS: 1800 U. S. Census, Fairfield Dist., SC; Two Ferguson listed, a William, page 223; 00111-00101-00. This would indicate that William was over age 45, his wife was age 26-45 or older; he had two young males and 1 young female living in his household. Second Ferguson, Isaac, 22300100-01000-00. This Isaac appears to be younger than William. He also had 7 young males and 1 young female in the house.

This is a wealthy farmer. The Ferguson and Bouldin family might have worked for him.

Ferguson Homeplace in Pickens Co, SC, Somewhere near Clayton Mills, Six Mile. Notice a Ferguson Road North off of Hwy 183. A Ferguson Family Cemetery that is 2 mile NE of Six-Mile, SC is listed on the internet as on page 172 of the Old Pendleton District Genealogy Society Cemetery book. GPS- N 34 53.759 x W82 40.251. This would also be near the Ferguson Road. Hwy 183 is the road west to old Pickens village and the Walhalla Bridge over the Oconee River. Both the Perry and Youngblood families lived near the Oconee River. The Perry family were buried at Six Mile Baptist Church. Others were buried in Oconee County near Walhalla.

The "Old Ferguson Place" on Kings Mountain, was part of 500 acres on headwaters of middle fork of Crowders Creek, S. slope of Kings Mountain, granted to Robert. Andrew Sr. bought 200 acres adjoining the Old Home Place in 1783. see will of Robert.

This Andrew Ferguson Jr. was born 1778 and d 1860 in St. Louis, Missouri.

Of Fairfield Dist, SC. The following was posted in reply to my query of Oct 2006:

The Equity Court Records for Fairfield County has the following info: __Bill 1830#1 filed on April 27, 1826: __Abraham Ferguson, under 14 died on July 20, 1824, he was a son of Anna Ferguson; George R. Hunter was the exr. of the will of Abram Ferguson and was appointed the guardian of Ann Ferguson who was above 14 but under 21, no relation given between Abram Ferguson and anyone.

The story of how Mr. and Mrs. Boling came to orrville is on unusual interest. When the Civil war began in 1861 Boling was a resident of South Carolina, the first state to secede from the Union. He was one of the first to fight for the Confederacy. Leaving his wife at home, Boling enlisted and fought during practically the whole three years of the terrible conflict.

Near the close of the war the portion of the Confederate army in which he fought, surrendered and the soldiers were shipped into northern states. Boling was brought to Wayne county and put off the train at Orrville. The war ended soon after this, and he corresponded with Mrs. Boling, who had remained in the south. She joined him at Orrville and they lived there until his death. Mrs. Boling is survived by one son who is an express messenger at Mt. Wayne, Ind.

Mary married **Berry E. Boling** on 4 Apr 1861 in Pickensville, Pickens, SC.

Berry was born in 1838 in Pickens Co, SC. He died in 1901/1910 in Wayne Co, OH.

NAME: Spelling in records, varies from Bolan, Bolin, Bolding, Bouldin. Bowldin, Baldwin. Since many Boldings are buried at cemeteries in Pickens Co, sc the preferred spelling is Bolding. See records of Mtn. View Cemetery. Death Certificate and Obituary for his wife, has Boling.

MARRIAGE: First marriage for Berry Bouldin was to Ruthy A. b 1842 Pickens Co, SC. This wife and the children must have died before 1861 or else this is the wrong Berry.

Wife, Rebecca 48, other children: Daniel P. 21; William N.; Goerge W. 15; Benjamin M. 13; Elizabeth J. 12; Catherine 11; Rebecca S. 10, all born Pickens, SC. This is more likely the correct Berry, but hthe head of the house is not William.? The name of this family is spelled Bolding on their gravestones and in their family Book. BOLDING FAMILY: Jonathan Lee Bolding 1806-1879, A Pioneer of the Pea Ridge Section of Pickens Co, SC by Agnes Bolding Lesley, revised 1985. A copy is in the Clayton Room of the Southern Wesleyan College in Central, SC. The family graves were found by V. Austin at Mountain View Cemetery at the end of Ferguson Road, West of Pickens, SC. This mountain is probably Pea Ridge?

His mother may be the Mary Bowldin 50, female \$50 pp, b Pickens Co, SC who is living next to James Furgison in Clayton Mills, 5th Reg page 177B. Her family includes Winna Bowldin 17, fem, SC; Mattison 12, SC; Joseph 10 SC; Sarah Jones 30, SC and George W. Jones 4 SC; William 2 SC. Also, this Mary could be a sister to Mahala or James Furgison.

The next household 199-212 is Alexander Sweeney 51, a Superintendant of the Infirmary, who oversees the Institute; his wife Sarah A, 48, and son Franklin, who works in the ward.

The obit was in the Wooster Daily Republican, 16 June 1893, Page 1. GEORGE FERGUSON, AGED ABOUT 40 YEARS, AN INMATE OF THE INFIRMARY, DIED THIS MORNING OF BLOOD POISONING RESULTING FROM OLD SORES. 3. **William J. M. Ferguson** (James) was born in Apr 1835 in Anderson, SC. He died in 1900/1910 in Cherokee Co, TX.

Footnotes for William J. M. Ferguson

PARENTS: After studying the 1850 census of Pickens, SC where William J. M. enlisted in the CSA, Of all the Ferguson families of Pickens County, the one that has a William of about the right age is James and wife Mahala. No other Ferguson family fits the profile. Another researcher, Carolyn Hays (john_hays@sbcglobal.net also believes that because Mahala and son George W. are living next door in 1870 to W. J. M, she must be their mother.

NOTE: H.Austin Oct 2006. Since William of the 1860 census of Pickens Co, SC is said to be born in Anderson Co. abt 1837, and since James Ferguson of the Anderson Co, SC 1840 census is the only Ferguson listed on the census for that place, this should be one proof that William is the son of James. Also we know that the William J.M. who enlisted 1861 at Pickensville in the CSA and the William J. M. of the 1870 census of Lawrence Co, AL is the same age, and of the same name is living next door to M.E. Ferguson (Mahala) and G.W. (George) I believe that this family of James and Mahala Ferguson of Pickens and Anderson are the parents of William J. M. No other Ferguson family of the 1850 or 1860 census has a son William of the correct age.
